

Sligo Water System, Inc.
WATER USER AGREEMENT
(Resident of Plantation Acres Mobile Home Community)

This Agreement entered between the SLIGO WATER SYSTEM. INC., a nonprofit corporation, hereinafter as required by the Bylaws of the Water system.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, promises, and agreements herein contained, it is hereby understood and agreed by the parties hereto as follows:

The Water System shall furnish, subject to the limitation set out in its Bylaws and Rules of Regulations now in force or as hereafter amended, water service in connection with Member's occupancy of the following described property:

The Member agrees to comply with and be bound by the Articles, Bylaws, Rules and Regulations of the Water System, now in force, or hereafter duly and legally supplemented, amended, or changed. The Member also agrees to pay for water at such rates, times, and place as shall be determined by the Water System, and agrees to imposition of such penalties for noncompliance as are now set out in the Water System Bylaws and Rules and Regulations, or which may be hereafter adopted and imposed by the Water System.

The Water System shall purchase and install a cut off valve and include a water meter in each new service. The Water System shall have Exclusive right to use such cutoff and water meter.

The Water System shall have final authority in any question of location of any service line connection to its distribution system, shall determine the allocation of water shortage, and may shut off water to a member who allows a connection or extension to be made of the Member's service line for the purpose of supplying water to another user. In the event the total water supply shall be insufficient to meet all the needs of the members, or in the events there is a shortage of water, the Water System may prorate the water available among various Members on such basis as is deemed equitable by the Board of Directors, and may also prescribe a schedule of hours covering use of water for garden purposes by particular Members and require adherence thereto or prohibit the use of water for garden purposes, provided that, if at any time the total water supply shall be insufficient to meet all the needs of all members. The Water System must first satisfy all the needs of all the members for both domestic and livestock purposes before supplying water for garden purposes.

The member agrees to pay: a **membership fee in the amount of \$25.00,**
a setup fee in the amount of \$15.00
and a deposit in the Amount of \$125.00
a total of \$165.00.

In the event service to the member is terminated, either voluntarily by the member, or by the Association for any cause, the membership fee and the setup fee shall be held by the Association. The Deposit will be refunded after the account is a balance of \$0.00.

The Member shall commence to use water from the system on the date the water is made available to the member by the Water System. Water charges to the Member shall commence on the date service is made available, regardless of whether the member connects to the system.

The Failure of a customer to pay water charges duly imposed shall result in the automatic imposition of the following penalties:

1. Nonpayment within 10 days from the due date will be subject to a penalty of ten percent of the delinquent account.
2. Nonpayment within 30 days from the due date will result in the water being shut off from the customer's property.
3. In the Event, it becomes necessary for the Water System to shut off the water from Member's property, a **\$75.00** fee set by the corporation in its rate schedule will be charged for reconnection of the service.
4. A **\$25.00 return check fee** for all return check, water may be subject for disconnect for non-payment.
5. Tampering with a Meter or stealing services from a municipal utility is unlawful and such utilities are protected by municipal ordinance (section 1-8, 98-104) and State law (R.S. 14:67.6). Said violation is subject to a fine of up to \$500.00 or imprisonment of not more than 60 days, or both. Additionally, should tampering include any destruction of city property, additional criminal charges may be filed.
